Can Forests Help Fight Cancer?

Walks in the forest may be responsible for activating natural killer (NK) cells known to attack cancer and increase certain anti-cancer proteins. This is the claim of the Nippon Medical School and the Forest Products Research Institute of Japan. Research on 12 highly stressed males showed that NK cell activity increased by 52.6 percent after just two days of walking in the woods. Additional experiments are planned, but Japan's Forestry Agency is already saying that this is further evidence of the therapeutic effects of forests.

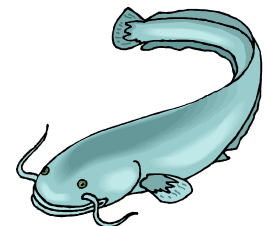


Arkansas Game & Fish Commission to Stock Fishing Pond
