TENNIS ANYONE! Just a few more days of school left- What are you doing this summer?

Now it's time to start planning your summer schedule for the kids. We will have group tennis lessons starting for pee-wee (5 & 6 yr olds) beginners and advanced beginners. Beginner's will be grouped by ages, usually, 8-10 yr old and 10-12 yr old.

Groups will be formed after we meet and see what levels we have. Most classes will begin at 9am, Monday - Thursday, with private lessons on Friday and any extra time for make-up. Some Saturday and Sunday will be offered, also.

Pee-Wee is 6 lessons for 45 minutes - \$36 --- Beginner is 6 lessons for one hour - \$48

I do offer private lessons for \$30/hour or \$15 for half hour. You can also bring a friend to share your time, sometimes that's fun for friends to take lessons together!

I will talk to anyone that is interested in lessons and encourage them to come out to meet me and hit with me so I can determine what group they belong in.

This will begin in June, since we have lessons going on now after school. Adult lessons are also offered.

The Nature Conservancy's Professional Fire Team in conjunction with Audubon Arkansas and Rocket Properties, LLC conducted a control burn last month on a 2 1/2 acre field north of the Tallgrass neighborhood. This was done as part of our commitment to conservation and wildlife habitat restoration. The purpose of the burn was to remove less desirable and invasive grasses and weed species, recycle nutrients back to the soil and to prepare a seed bed for wildflower establishment. Fire is an ancient yet one of the most effective tools for land and prairie management available to mankind. Historically, wildfires would

occur every seven to nine years naturally and have helped to maintain various ecosystems throughout the ages. We are just now getting back to emulating nature for long term sustainability. This control burn was a first for Woodlands Edge and is probably the first within a community in Little Rock and likely in the State of Arkansas!

P.S. This can only be done by professionals under the utmost scrutiny and with required city and state permits.
